CALL TO ORDER

APPROVAL OF MINUTES OF JANUARY 3, 2006

Commissioner Reiss made a motion to approve the minutes as submitted. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Nichols and passed unanimously.

SYCAMORE CANYON EQUESTRIAN CENTER LEASE UPDATE

Mr. Duran reported that the next steps with the new Sycamore Canyon Lease will be for the Adairs to submit for a revised Conditional Use Permit and for the City and Adairs to develop the capital improvement project list. Councilman McHenry explained the Conditional Use Permit process.

SYCAMORE CREEK TRAIL UPDATE

Mr. Duran reported that the Sycamore Creek trail is nearing completion after the revisions to the retaining. He added that he walked the entire length of the trail last week and encouraged the Commission to ride the trail and provide feedback. Councilman McHenry elaborated on some of the changes to the trail.

COMMUNITY ARENA UPDATE

Mr. Duran reported that repairs have been made to the irrigation booster pump which should improve pressure to the arena. Councilman McHenry suggested that someone who knows how to set the variable speed pump needs to make sure it is set properly.

ASSISTANT CITY MANAGER REPORT

Mr. Duran reported that there is a proposed 7 lot sub-division that will be coming before the Commission in the near future.

MEMBERS OF THE AUDIENCE

Kay Hager commented that Corral 35's clean-up committee has been doing trail maintenance.

Councilman McHenry gave an overview of the NJD land swap proposal with Glendora Country Club in Glendora.
