Commissioner Sloniker noted the Park Police are looking for a new location – how about the old Sheriff's Station? Flood Control is willing to come and talk to us.

Commissioner Nash appreciated the vinyl equestrian fence installation – felt it was a good improvement. He is glad the farmers market is back.

Vice Chair Anderson asked when the trauma helicopter will be moving. Staff to contact Chief Freeman.
