1. CALL TO ORDER

Mayor Morris called the special meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. and led the flag salute.

2. ORAL COMMUNICATIONS

3. POST ELECTION PROCEDURES

- a. Statement of Results

(1) ADOPTION OF **RESOLUTION NO. 09-13**, A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIMAS, CALIFORNIA, RECITING THE FACT OF THE GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION HELD ON MARCH 3, 2009, DECLARING THE RESULT AND SUCH OTHER MATTERS AS PROVIDED BY LAW.

After the title was read, it was moved by Councilmember Ebiner, seconded by Mayor Pro Tem Badar, to waive further reading and adopt RESOLUTION NO. 09-13, A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIMAS, CALIFORNIA, RECITING THE FACT OF THE GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION HELD ON MARCH 3, 2009, DECLARING THE RESULT AND SUCH OTHER MATTERS AS PROVIDED BY LAW. The motion carried unanimously.

The City Clerk entered the Statement of Results of the General Municipal Election as required by the State Elections Code as attached hereto and made a part thereof.

- b. Oath of Office.

The City Clerk administered the oath of office and presented Certificates of Election to Mayor Morris and Councilmembers Bertone and Templeman.

c. Remarks from Mayor and Councilmembers.

1) Councilmember Bertone thanked his wife/Campaign Manager Diana, and congratulated Mayor Morris and Councilmember Templeman on their victory. He thanked City Manager Michaelis and his staff for a well-run city and thanked the citizens of San Dimas for their confidence in him. He hopes to live up to their expectations. He recognized supporters and volunteers Margie Green, Alta and Jim Skinner, and Mitch Crawford for all their assistance.

2) Councilmember Templeman thanked his family for their support and greatly appreciates the assistance of Mary Ann Stubblefield, Margie Green, Mitch Crawford, David Bratt, David Harbin, John Davis and all the volunteers who helped him create a strong bond with the community. He is honored and committed to serving the citizens of San Dimas for the next four years. Councilmember Templeman commented that a recent editorial described the Cities of San Dimas and La Verne as "the best run cities in the San Gabriel Valley."

3) Mayor Morris thanked his wife Glenda and those people who did not run against him. He also thanked supporters Margie Green and Jim Skinner who helped with his limited campaign. He congratulated Councilmembers Bertone and Templeman who deserve to be re-elected and interprets the results of the election as strong endorsement of the current administration. He highlighted completed projects that will bring in revenue and praised City Manager Michaelis and staff who are cognizant of the difficult financial years ahead.
