- I. Welcome and Call to Order  
Meeting called to order by Chair Don Handley at 5:31 pm.
- II. Business from the public not on the agenda

- III. Approval of the January 20, 2009 minutes – Commissioners absent from the meeting abstained.
- IV. Presentation from the California Highway Patrol – Baldwin Park Division serving our area.

Lt. Hammond introduced himself and PIO Zorilla from the Baldwin Park CHP region. Lt. Hammond provided some statistics – 16 reported collisions in the San Dimas Service area over the past 5 years. That number is favorable – state wide CHP handles around 228,000 collisions in 1 year. There are about 100 sworn officers out of the Baldwin Park CHP station. They serve the area from Monrovia west to the county line, and from the 60 freeway north to the foothills. They provide services through the CAL GRIP program – which includes grants for specialized activities in working with other agencies. They provide public safety services in some unincorporated areas on state highways, safe streets work, and assist agencies when requested. In some cases they have been involved with gang suppression activity. In the Baldwin Park service area they encountered 33 fatalities in 2006 and 2007; and 26 in 2008. In the San Dimas service corridor, they had 86 enforcement contacts in 2006, 63 in 2007 and 123 in 2008. Commissioners asked general questions. The Commission thanked the CHP for coming to the meeting.
