CALL TO ORDER

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. by Chair Reiss.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES OF APRIL 7, 2009

Since there was not a quorum of Commissioners who were at the April 7, 2009 meeting, the approval of the minutes was deferred until the next meeting.

TRAIL CLEAN-UP DAY

The Commissioners discussed the details for the upcoming May 16th trail clean-up. They discussed needing a minimum number of volunteers to make the clean up worth while.

FARMERS MARKET BOOTH

Mr. Duran confirmed the Commission has a booth reserved at the Farmers Market for May 6th and 13th. He shared with them literature that had been made available last year. The Commissioners discussed staffing for the booth.

ASSISTANT CITY MANAGERS REPORT

Mr. Duran reported that the City had received official notification from T-Mobile that they are not moving forward with the cell tower / arena lights project at the Community Arena. He added that they said the project became too expensive for today's market. Commissioner Reiss asked how much a lighting project would cost on its own. Mr. Duran responded that would have to be something that would be costed out. The Commissioners discussed that this could still be an important project and that possibly

seeking grants or raising funds in the community might be a way to fund it. Mr. Duran responded that he will start to get some preliminary cost estimates for a project.

CITY COUNCIL REPORT

Councilman Templeman reported that in June the City Council will be reviewing the City's current prohibition of RVs being parked in driveways. He gave a history of how the review came about.

Councilman Templeman provided an update on the Grove Station project and the project on San Dimas Canyon Road at Bonita Avenue. He also provided an update on the City Hall expansion project.
