08-09-01 CALAVERAS ROAD

REQUEST FROM DEBBY LERCH, RESIDENT: Request to install speed humps on Calaveras Road in the Village at San Dimas neighborhood. Petition Requesting Installation of Speed Humps includes signatures of 146 residents from surrounding streets accessed by Calaveras Road.

08-09-02 CALAVERAS ROAD AND KELSEY ROAD

REQUEST FROM DEBBY LERCH, RESIDENT: Request for painted crosswalks at the 4-way stop controlled intersection at Calaveras Road and Kelsey Road.

08-09-03 PASEO PLACITA (VIA VERDE)

REQUEST FROM ANN BERGMAN, RESIDENT: Request to paint red curb in front of fire hydrant at 1320 Paseo Placita.

08-09-04 VIA VERDE- BONELLI PARK / 57 SOUTH FREEWAY ON-RAMP

REQUEST FROM NICOLE BAUTISTA, RESIDENT: Request to add a "freeway entrance" left turn lane on Via Verde for 57 S-bound traffic so motorists do not have to wait in line with vehicles entering Bonelli Park on festival or other busy days.

08-09-05 BONITA AVENUE

REQUEST FROM MICHAEL BOURQUE, DIRECTOR OF CONSTRUCTION, MOUNTAIN VIEW APTS: Request for red curb in front of monument sign at 650 E. Bonita Avenue (Mountain View Apartments) to prevent cars from blocking view of the signage.

08-09-06 WALNUT AVENUE

REQUEST FROM JENNE GILBERT, RESIDENT: Request to paint red curb in front of fire hydrant at 251 S. Walnut Avenue.

08-09-07 FIFTH STREET- AMELIA AVENUE TO ACACIA STREET

REQUEST FROM STAFF: With recent completion of 5th Street widening and reconstruction, residents in the area have reported an increase in speeding. Consider adding a double yellow line and speed limit signs on 5th Street from Amelia Avenue to Cataract.

CONTINUED ITEMS

05-09-05 BONITA AVENUE AND PONY EXPRESS

TRAFFIC ENGINEER'S REPORT ON REQUEST FROM SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT: Consider two hour time restricted AM and PM peak/No U-Turn signage for eastbound left turning traffic making U-turn movements at Pony Express. The turning movement at peak hours makes it difficult for patrol cars heading westbound from Pony Express.
