- I. Welcome and Call to Order  
Meeting called to order by Chair Jim Sloniker at 5:30 pm.

- III. Approval of the February 17, 2009 minutes – Commissioners absent from the meeting abstained.

- V. Brief introduction to the Los Angeles County Fire Terrorism mission from Commissioner Alva.

Commissioner Alva explained some of the history, background and function of the JRIC program to identify and disseminate information that may be of help with early warnings of terrorism activity. Commissioner Alva reviewed some of the accomplishments and success of the program.

- VII. Reports from Staff

Captain Hartshorne provided a report on the successful gun retirement program, Every 15 Minutes student drinking and driving program, and other general Department activities. Fire representative noted that the annual brush clearing inspection are underway, a recent horse/rider rescue and assistance, and participation in the Every 15 Minutes program.

City Manager Michaelis provided an update on the city's budget and the continuation of public safety services.

VIII. Reports from Commissioners

Commissioner Ortiz inquired if there are procedures and practices in place for the reporting of the potential for a weapon on school campuses. It was noted that there are procedures and protocols in place with the requirement to hold exercises on those procedures – one is coming up next month.

Commissioner Campbell noted there are maintenance issues on a property a couple of houses away from Gladstone and Walnut.

Commissioner Molina asked if businesses are notified when there has been a higher incidence of crime in a particular. The Department note that they often give crime prevention advice to businesses.
