CALL TO ORDER

The meeting was called to order at 6:00 p.m. by Chair Cook.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES OF FEBRUARY 1, 2011

Commissioner DeMonaco made a motion to approve the minutes of February 1, 2011 as submitted. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Pike and approved unanimously.

TRAIL CLEAN-UP PROJECT APRIL 9, 2011

Mr. Duran reported on the publicity that has gone out for the April 9th trail clean-up project. He distributed flyers to the Commissioners and they coordinated on distributing to the community.

They reviewed some of their notes from the prior year and coordinated activities for that day. Mr. Duran offered to provide sign-up sheets, name tags and volunteer verification forms. The Commission discussed and divided up assignments. They agreed to discuss a shopping list for food at the April meeting.

CITY COUNCIL REPORT

Councilman Templeman encouraged everyone to vote in next Tuesday's election. He reported on a scheduled open house for the renovated civic center on April 12th.

Councilman Templeman reported that the City approved a new location for the Farmer's Market on First St. and Civic Center parking lot for the upcoming season. He reported on

the latest developments with the State budget and the proposal for the elimination of local Redevelopment Agencies.

COMMISSIONERS COMMENTS

Commissioner DeMonaco commented that someone asked when the City accepts applications for the Commission. Mr. Duran responded that the City advertises when there is a vacancy. Commissioner Aschenbrenner responded that he does not intend to request reappointment when his term is up in July. Councilman Templeman suggested that he submit a letter to the City Council so they can begin advertising for the vacancy.

Chair Cook commented that there are still damaged fence rails in front of Crystal Indian Springs on Baseline. Mr. Duran responded that he will have Parks staff contact the homeowners association again.

Commissioner Picconi reported that on the Strawberry trail just east of the Face trail there is a branch sticking out into the trail.
