- I. Welcome and Call to Order
 Meeting called to order by Chair Nash at 5:30 pm.
- II. Business from the public not on the agenda – Ray Bradshaw from Charter Cove Cruisers noted his experience in the weapons simulator facility recently. He wondered if the trailer could be available for a future event of his club May 22. Captain Slawson to respond. Former Commissioner Dave Campbell presented the plaque from the recent Baker to Vegas run event.
- III. Approval of the January 18, 2011 Minutes – Commissioners absent from the meeting abstained from the approval.
- IV. Introduction of Don Slawson – new Captain of San Dimas Station
- V. Thank you to retiring Commissioners – Olander and Campbell
- VI. Explanation of the city’s contract with the Sheriff’s Department and Fire Services arrangement.
 City Manager Michaelis provided an overview – summary attached. Michaelis also explained the Fire District operation.
- VII. Reports from Staff
 Chief Pena noted there were two new Battalion Chiefs at Station 64 – A shift is Dave Thies, B shift is Robert Ryan. Chief Pena answered questions about the upcoming fire season and the beneficial impact of the rather wet winter.
- VIII. Reports from Commissioners
 Commissioner Ortiz asked about the city’s process to review massage parlors. Mayor Morris outlined the process. Noted mailer from SEIU challenging the level of care at San Dimas Community Hospital – perhaps to encourage SEIU growth. Commented on the

recent birthing center reports in the newspaper and seeing a customer rolling out 3 shopping carts of baby formula in March at a San Dimas store. Commissioner McCants reported seeing two southbound Iglesia left turns turning before the median island into oncoming traffic.
