TRAILS UPDATE

Mr. Duran reviewed the Final Northern Foothills Trails Study. He pointed out that there were changes made to the review of the Shirlimar Trail. He added that after further review by the engineers they came to the same conclusion that repairs to that trail were infeasible. He added that the schedule is to have the City Council review the final study within the next few months so they have information to assist them in making decisions on the NJD south 40 acres.
