**STATEMENT OF INTENT**

Working under the direction of the City’s Project Manager and Director of Public Works, the selected CM firm shall provide qualified personnel to perform construction management and other related services for the construction of the Bikeway Improvements and Bridge Widening at Foothill Boulevard over San Dimas Wash. These services shall include construction surveying, construction inspection services, office contract administration, material testing, source inspection and other services as outlined in this scope of work. Survey personnel shall work under the direction of a surveyor licensed by the State of California. Inspection personnel shall be full time and/or on an as needed basis, and shall provide assistance to, and work under the direction of the selected CM firm’s Resident Engineer. Material testing shall be conducted in a Caltrans certified laboratory by appropriately accredited personnel. Prior to the commencement of construction activity, the selected CM firm shall provide qualified personnel to perform a constructability review of the project plans and specifications to identify any potential construction related issues for discussion at the preconstruction conference.
