Job Description

The City of San Dimas Parks and Recreation Department offers a basketball league for youth ages 8-14 that emphasizes teaching fundamentals, sportsmanship, teamwork and fun. Practices are four days per week from 3:15 - 6:00 p.m. and games are played on Saturdays, 8:00 a.m. - 2:00 p.m. (all times approximate)

Representative Duties

- ❑ Responsible for planning, organizing and supervising basketball practices.
- ❑ Responsible for the general safety and well-being of the children of the assigned team.

Qualifications

Previous coaching experience and the ability to instruct and work with children are preferred. Knowledge of the rules and regulations of basketball is helpful. Minimum of graduation from high school or the equivalent and any combination of experience and education that could likely provide the desired knowledge and abilities.
