SUBJECT: Community Safety Planning and Preparation. Presentation from the Sheriff's Department.

SUMMARY

The December attack in San Bernardino brought terrorism closer to our personal lives. We all began to think of what we would do if we faced such an incident. As an employer, we shared some background information and recommendations on what to do under such circumstances. The Sheriff's Department recently provided well received training and information for business owners through a session coordinated by the Chamber of Commerce. We felt it would be a good idea to take some time in a study session setting with you to have the Sheriff's Department go over their preparations and protocols when they are called to respond to an active shooter situation.
