CALL TO ORDER

The meeting was called to order at 6:00 p.m. by Chair Sevier.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES OF OCTOBER 6, 2015

Vice Chair Picconi made a motion to approve the minutes of October 6, 2015 with the correction to show Commissioner Medlin was present. The motion was seconded by Commissioner DeMonaco and passed unanimously.

PROVIDE INPUT TO WASTE MANAGEMENT REGARDING POTENTIAL  
MANURE RECYCLING

Mr. Duran reported that the City has been working with Waste Management for some time trying to develop a manure collection and recycling program. He added that one of the challenges has been identifying the properties that have horses and the volume of manure that currently is being disposed of. He added that Waste Management has attempted to identify properties that potentially could have horses and sent out a survey to those properties. He further added that it was suggested that the Commissioners could provide insight to Waste Management on how horse owners currently dispose of their manure.

Teri Muse, Waste Management explained how they attempted to identify potential horse keeping properties and described the survey and the mixed results they received with responses. She shared some of the results of the survey. Some of the Commissioners
