The Big Meow is open to residents of the following cities:

Chino, Chino Hills, Claremont, Diamond Bar, Glendora, La Verne, Montclair, Ontario, Pomona, San Dimas, and the unincorporated areas of San Bernardino County including West End, San Antonio Heights, and Mt. Baldy. (Must have proof of residency) You must make your appointment in our office prior to the spay or neuter date.

Qualifying cats:

Cats must be 4 months - 4 years of age.

In cities requiring a cat license (Diamond Bar, Pomona & La Verne) all cats over 4 months must have a current license.

Maximum of 3 per household.

Owned, outdoor cats only (no wild cats will be accepted).

Cats must be in a properly secured kennel or carrier.

Cats must be micro-chipped. You can purchase a micro-chip for \$30.

Space is limited and is subject to first come first serve basis. No phone calls please.

To sign up you will need to:

Come to the shelter. The Inland Valley Humane Society & SPCA sign up hours are 9:30 am - 5:00 pm Monday through Saturday and 9:30 am - 6:30 pm on Wednesday's.

Fill out the paperwork.

Provide proof of residency.

Drop off times are between the hours of 7:00 am - 8:30 am, pick up is the same day between 2:00 pm - 4:00 pm.

What is Included in the Program?

- Spay or neuter
- Vaccines (FVRCP and Rabies)
- One month application of flea and tick control
- Basic health care at the time of surgery
