

SUBJECT: July Meeting

- Trail Clean-up Review – We had to cancel the annual trail clean-up event due to lack of pre-registered participants. Are there any preliminary thoughts as to changing, modifying or discontinuing the event entirely? It would be helpful for the out-going members of the Commission to pass on their historical perspective of the event.
- Western Days – Due to the downtown Bonita Ave. project the Western Days event, including the parade, will be suspended this year. For the past several years, the Commissioners have been very involved in assisting with the equestrian aspects of the parade. With the suspension of Western Days and the parade this year, this gives the City and Chamber an opportunity to evaluate the overall event. It would be of benefit to receive feedback from the Commissioners who have been involved in the parade in the past regarding the parade in general and specifically the equestrian element.
- I will provide updates at the meeting on the development projects that impact equestrian zoned properties in the City.
- Commissioners DeMonaco and Piccone's terms expire this month so this will be their last meeting. We will thank them for their service on the Commission. We are currently soliciting applications for new commissioners, if you know of someone who might be a good candidate we would suggest that you encourage them to apply.
