#05-16-01 LONE HILL AVE & CYPRESS

REQUEST FROM RESIDENT, to review and consider installation of No U-turn signage on Lone Hill near middle school to prevent vehicles v pedestrian accidents. Resident also requests review of mph speed limit on Cypress east of Lone Hill which is currently 40pmh due to March 8th accident with a pedestrian within crosswalk.
