**A.        Review of San Dimas Recreation Center Programs**

Supervisor Jones and Coordinator Ward distributed copies of the San Dimas Recreation Center Staff and Program Overview. Coordinator Ward reviewed staffing at the Center and Supervisor Jones reviewed programs currently held at the Center. Coordinator Ward explained the Center passes and fees. She also outlined the Teen Center/Student Union programs. Supervisor Jones identified community partnerships and future goals of the Center.

Manager Raya stated that the current trend is to build multi-use recreational facilities geared towards multi-generational patrons.

C. City Council Liaison

Councilmember Ebner announced that the council would be reviewing the prospective annual budget at a study session meeting on Tuesday, May 22 at 5pm. He said Commissioners are welcome to attend.

Councilmember Ebner stated CicLAvia was a very successful event with over 50,000 people in attendance.

Councilmember Ebner stated that he has enjoyed working with director Bruns and that she will be missed.

Commissioner Pike wanted to add that the Equestrian Trail Cleanup Day was cancelled this year due to lack of participation. She proposed for next year a trail cleanup day that could be a community event incorporating trail and wildlife education.

Director Bruns stated that staff is also discussing other options for Equestrian Trail Cleanup Day.
